Human trafficking is ...

A growing problem in Canada, and more specifically, in York Region. Human Trafficking is the exploitation, manipulation or control of a person (usually a female) by violence or threats of violence to provide a sexual service or forced labour¹.

The most common form of human trafficking in York Region is sex trafficking. The average age that young girls are exploited is age 13 or 14. According to Statistics Canada, more than 93% of human trafficking victims are female, and almost half are between the ages of 18 to 24 with 25% of all victims under the age of 18.
