FOOD BRINGS LIFE & HOPE

LEBANON – Because of your generous donations, NCM Canada was able to support a Canadian Baptist Ministries /Canadian Foodgrains Bank food assistance project in Lebanon providing food for 766 Syrian refugee families. 72 percent of refugee households in this particular area of Lebanon fall below the Survival Minimum (food) Basket of \$2.90 USD per day. 88.9 percent live below the poverty line for this context. Limited economic opportunities, especially during the colder months of the year, makes it very diffi-



cult for these families to find work and to access food. High inflation rates, high consumer prices, and political and economic instability in Lebanon were aggravated by the recent port explosion. Add to this the impact of the COVID-19 and lockdowns limiting movement and disrupting food supply chains. Always, the poorest and the marginalized are most negatively impacted.

Thank you for giving for Lebanon relief...your donations are saving lives and bringing hope to these families.

CREATIVE ACCESS AREA (AFRICA)

The people in this creative access area of West Africa have experienced extreme hardship and food insecurity because of famine, then flooding, and now COVID-19. Most of the crops failed and when the government imposed lockdown, the situation became desperate. This food assistance project targeted 238 households (about 1500 people)



who were the most needy and marginalized in these communities. Our church leaders were able to partner

with a registered NGO to carry out the distribu-

AFGHANISTAN – Your gifts to NCM Canada / Canadian Foodgrains Bank are helping support a food assistance project initiated by Presbyterian World Service and Development in Banyam province. More than 25% of the population is in a food crisis situation. COVID-19 has exasperated the situation reducing travel to markets, disrupting food supply chains, reducing employment opportunities, and reduction of aid. Where there is food in the markets, an emergency cash for food package is being provided for over 1500 needy families to help ensure their survival.

BICYCLES HELP GROW THE CHURCH

In our last newsletter we reported that your giving enabled us to provide 138 bicycles to Pastors in Bangladesh. These bicycles had been purchased by Canadian Nazarenes through the NCM Canada Gift Catalogue.

The gift of bicycles was very timely. COVID infections were rising and all local transportation has ceased due to government lockdown. All pastors in Bangladesh pastor 4-5 churches. The bicycles enabled them to continue to visit and care for their congregations even though church buildings were closed.

One pastor commented "It says in Isaiah 41, 'Don't be afraid, for I am with you. Don't be discouraged for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you....' God is with us in every situation. We were able to continue our ministry. When our people cannot come to church, we can go to them".

NCM Canada learned that 3 new churches were planted in these areas during the worst days of the pandemic – because you gave bicycles!

REPAIRS TO 2 SCHOOLS BRING NEW LIFE AND HOPE TO CHILDREN IN JORDAN:

The schools required significant improvements to the toilet facilities, selected classrooms, staff rooms, computer labs, playgrounds, windows and doors etc. In total 315 children per year are enrolled in these



schools - schools a combination of Jordanian, Syrian, Iraqi and other children from low income and refugee families in the surrounding community.

A third grade student commented, "The school looks like new."

Your generous gifts for **Anti-Human Trafficking in Canada** have enabled us to provide some funding to three Canadian organizations fighting human trafficking in our nation.

\$3000 was provided to Next Step Ministries of Calgary. This Christian organization that helps meet the needs of vulnerable and exploited people, particularly women exiting sexual exploitation and helps them move towards a life of hope and healing.

\$6000 was gifted to u-r Home, a Christian agency north of Toronto providing safe homes for girls / women rescued from human trafficking. This agency worked with NCM Canada to develop our Anti-Human Trafficking Information kit for parents and churches. See www.ncmcanada.ca.

\$3000 was gifted to U-Turn Housing, a division of Youth For Christ in central Alberta that provides housing and services for at-risk youth.
